YOU'RE NEVER TOO OLD TO FLOAT YOUR BOAT!

That is the motto of the *Not So Ancient Mariners* - Bayview residents who were the first and only team of seniors to enter Seafair's Milk Carton Derby in its 48-year history!

Last September, a committee was formed and a design created. Residents, staff and the families of our Children's Center collected hundreds of milk cartons. Space was cleared (during our major renovation!) for residents to build the boat. Try-outs were held for residents wanting to be on the boat crew. Jeff Goldsmith, Director of Fitness/Wellness trained them with exercises designed to build up their core, and paddling, muscles.

On July 14th, the boat was unloaded at Green Lake. Bayview's van brought supporters to join the staff, family members and residents who were already in place. The five-person crew – average age of 88 – donned life jackets, boarded the craft and headed out on the water to get their rhythm going. They veered off course as, reaching deeper (and colder) water, calamity struck one of the paddlers in the form of leg cramps. Chaos ensued and, while the boat was not in danger of sinking, it was listing due to the displacement of the occupants. Fearing that someone might fall off the listing boat and into the lake, a number




of people swam and paddle boarded to the rescue, towing the boat and crew to safety. King 5 News spent hours videotaping the morning's preparation, interviewing the captain (image below) and crew, and documenting the chaos and subsequent rescue. Unfortunately, they had to leave just after the mishap to edit the story for the evening broadcast.

BUT, that broadcast wasn't the end of the story! Once ashore, the team regrouped with a substitute paddler and fought their way to the finish line, arriving to the shouts of BAYVIEW! BAYVIEW! This group of not-so-ancient mariners may have finished last out of four entries but THEY FINISHED, making Seafair history.

Boat designs for 2019 are already being mulled over as Bayview's mariners heard they may have competition from another retirement community next year!


